Hasan is an interventional cardiologist trained in advanced coronary and peripheral vascular interventions. He specializes in treating ischemic heart disease, structural heart and valve disease, invasive coronary imaging, cardiomyopathy, coronary interventions and endovascular therapies for peripheral artery disease. Prior to joining Rush, Hasan was vice chair of the Heart and Vascular Institute at Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi, and helped establish a state-of-the-art extension of the Cleveland Clinic's model of care in the Middle East.

His clinical interests include endovascular therapies for complex lower extremity peripheral artery disease and percutaneous interventions for coronary artery disease including chronic total occlusions. Hasan has focused on treating patients with polyvascular disease and developing collaborative programs to manage this complex subset of patients.

His current research interests include clinical outcomes in patients with coronary artery disease and peripheral vascular disease, with a focus on global disparities in cardiovascular disease. He has extensive experience in optimizing quality and safety in the cardiac catheterization laboratory. Hasan's work has been published in leading cardiovascular journals, and he has presented abstracts at major national and international meetings. He serves as a peer reviewer for several heart and vascular journals.
